CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ALBERT I. NEEDHAM

of 4505 60th Avenue, N. E., Salem , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and North Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-40212, Permit No. R-4491 a tributary of Little Pudding River for the purpose of irrigation of 3.6 acres

under Permit No. 29993 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 25, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEL SWL, as projected within Pitney DLC 72, Section 4, T. 7 S., R. 2 W., W. M. Diversion point located 170 feet South and 1070 feet Fest from the NW Corner. Pitney DLC 72.

East from the NW Corner, Pitney DLC 72.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation secson of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under permit No. R-4491;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.8 acres NEt SW4
0.8 acre NW4 SW4
both as projected within Pitney DLC 72
Section 4
T. 7 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
