CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ALBERT HENKIN

of Box 295, Hebo, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed Creek, Farmer Creek and Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-38913, Permit No. R-3423 a tributary of Nestucca River for the purpose of fish culture

under Permit No. 28918 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 24, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second; being 0.50 c.f.s. from Unnamed Creek and 0.50 c.f.s. from Farmers Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 1, T. 4 S., R. 10 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4
SE 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 1
T. 4 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

Diversion points located: Unnamed Stream - 910 feet South and 2070 feet East; Farmers Creek - 860 feet South and 2620 feet East; both from the NW Corner, SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 1.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
