CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PAUL H. and MABEL L. CASSELL, successors in interest to Paul S. Seeley

of Route 1, Box 58, Rogue River, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of domestic, stock and irrigation of 5.3 acres and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1902

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.0 acres Lot 11 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
2.3 acres Lot 11 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 15
T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Paul H. and Mabel L. Cassell and recorded at page 32775, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 13.6 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion for irrigation of 8.3 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered February 2, 1967. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Paul H. and Mabel L. Cassell.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
