CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That P. B. HERMAN

of Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Applegate Rivera tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
irrigation of 15.0 acres
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from October 1900that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.30 cubic foot per
second

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:15.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$

T. 36 S., R. 6 W., W. M.Certificate of water right issued to P. B. Herman and recorded at page 16228,
Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use
of water for irrigation of 45.0 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion for
the irrigation of 30.0 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer
entered August 3, 1967. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining
right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore
issued to P. B. Herman.And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
