**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** JAMES S. INGLES

of Dufur, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Fifteen Mile Creek

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 15.0 acres

under Permit No. 8202 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 14, 1927

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.19 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Henderson DLC 37, SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 34, T. 1 S., R. 13 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 34  
T. 1 S., R. 13 E., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to James S. Ingles and recorded at page 31674, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 20.0 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 5.0 acres was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered June 14, 1968. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to James S. Ingles.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
