CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

EDWARD KINDEL

of Route 2, Box 237, Forest Grove , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of West Dairy Creek

a tributary of Tualatin River irrigation of 34.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 16759 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 5, 1,46

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.435 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWL NWL, as projected within the Richard Arthur DLC 43, Section 17, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.2 acres NWt NWt as projected within Richard Arthur DLC 43

26.0 acres SW NW as projected within Richard Arthur DLC 43

2.4 acres SEI NWI as projected within Richard Arthur DLC 43

1.0 acre NW as projected within Chas. Conklin DLC 53
Section 17

T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.

NOTE: Certificate of water right issued to Edward Kindel and recorded at page 27612, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 38.2 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion for the irrigation of 3.6 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered August 1, 1967. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Edward Kindel.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
