CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That R. W. RIMBACH

of Board of Trade Building, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-40058, Permit No. R-3983 a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of raising aquatic plants

under Permit No. 29733 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 11, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, as projected within Walker DLC 52, Section 13, T. 2 S., R. 1 E., W. M. Diversion point located 300 feet South and 1150 feet West from most Westerly Corner, DLC 52.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
