## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of Route 1, Echo , State of Oregon , has made p.oof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Umatilla River

a tributary of Columbia River irrigation of 1.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 29198 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 26, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWL NEL, Section 21, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W. M. Diversion point located 720 feet North and 120 feet East from the Center, Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 42 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and is subject to the policy program adopted by the State Water Resources Board on February 13, 1964 under ORS 536.300;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.6 acres SW NW NW Section 5
T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
