a tributary of Willamette River irrigation of 29.5 acres and stock use

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 28705 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 25, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second; being 0.01 c.f.s. for stock and 0.37 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW_{L}^{+} NE_{L}^{+} , as projected within Morris DLC 81, Section 6, T. 3 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Diversion points located 4110 feet North and 3030 feet West; 4570 feet North and 3160 feet West; both from the NW Corner, McSween DLC 80;

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
