under Permit No. 29252 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 29, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.78 cubic foot per second; being 0.26 c.f.s. from drain ditch and 0.52 c.f.s. from the spring

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL NEL; NW_{L}^{\perp} , NW_{L}^{\perp} , Section 12, T. 8 S., R. 38 E., W. M. Lot 2 (SW_{L}^{\perp} , NW_{L}^{\perp}), Section 7, T. 8 S., R. 39 E., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

From Drain Ditch

From Spring and Drain Ditch

Diversion points located 1150 feet South and 4290 feet West; 1900 feet South and 870 feet West; 1410 feet South and 490 feet East; all from the NE Corner, Section 12, T. 8 S., R. 38 E., W. M.
