or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $SE_{\pm}^{1}NW_{\pm}^{1}$, Section 28, T. 29 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Diversion point located 1800 feet South and 2670 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ---- of one cubic foot per second per acre,
