**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify**, That  
953 SE Main Street, Roseburg  
of P. O. Box 143, Roseburg, State of Oregon, has made proof  
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of  
Champagne Creek

EARL STONEROD and EDWARD M. MURPHY  
CHARLES H. and PATRICIA L. MAY

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 24.8 acres

under Permit No. 29244 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters  
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby  
confirmed dates from November 22, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.31 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , both as projected within La Point  
DLC 64, Section 6, T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second  
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited  
to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated  
during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to  
use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the South Umpqua River  
is more than 60 c.f.s. at its mouth;

and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is  
appurtenant, is as follows:

Diversion points located 660 feet South and 380 feet East; 370 feet South and 710  
feet East; 70 feet South and 1220 feet East; 440 feet South and 2020 feet East;  
all from NW Corner, DLC 64.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
