CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK DONNELLY

of Route 2, Box 212, McMinnville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of unnamed stream, tributary of Panther Creek, appropriated under Application No. 43080, Permit No. 32186

for the purposes of fish culture and duck pond under Reservoir Permit No. R-4906 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 1, 1966

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 6.05 acre feet; being 1.12 a.f. for fish culture and 4.93 a.f. for duck pond.
