CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK DONNELLY

of Route 2, Box 212, McMinnville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-43079, Permit No. R-4906 a tributary of Panther Creek for the purpose of fish culture and duck pond

under Permit No. 32186 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 1, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second; being 0.01 c.f.s. for fish culture and 0.10 c.f.s. for duck pond

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 5, T. 4 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion point located 4400 feet North and 520 feet East from SE Corner, Henderson DLC 87.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 4 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 5
T. 4 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The appropriation of water for the duck pond shall be limited to the period from October 1 to April 1 of the following year.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
