## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second; measured at the head of the ditch or the point where the same leaves the natural stream, from April 1 to October 1 of each year.

Certificate of water right issued to Charles Seefield and recorded at page 31424, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 10.0 acres, domestic, and stock. A change in the right to the use of water appurtenant to 8.0 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered September 4, 1968. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Charles Seefield.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and initiations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforescent is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
