CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

J. A. FELTON

of Nyssa , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Snake River

a tributary of Columbia River irrigation of 26.24 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 6742 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 25, 1925

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.33 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre.

Cortificate of water right issued to J. A. Felton and recorded at page 6099, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 135.0 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion for the irrigation of 108.76 acres was changed by order of the State Engineer entered April 5, 1968. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to J. A. Felton.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
