This Is to Certify, That FEDERAL LAND BANK

of Spokane, State of Washington, has a right
to the use of the waters of John Day River and Johnson Creek

irrigation of 142.0 acres and stock
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 15, at page 461; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1905

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed See Below

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, T. 8 S., R. 25 E., W. M. for
River and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, T. 8 S., R. 25 E., W. M. for Creek
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

Additional Pt. of Div.
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John Day River: one-fortieth cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April
1 to September 30; further limited to one acre-foot per acre
per calendar month; total of five acre-feet per acre for season,
measured at point of diversion.

Johnson Creek: one-fortieth cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June
1 and one-eightieth cubic foot per second per acre thereafter;
further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month to June 1
and four acre-feet per acre during season April 1 to September
30, measured at point of diversion.

Certificate of water right issued to Federal Land Bank and recorded at page 25162, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 150.8 acres. A change in the right to the use of water appurtenant to 8.8 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered June 4, 1968. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Federal Land Bank.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
