**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** HOMER L. WRIGHT and MARGARET J. WRIGHT

of Route 2, Box 237, Aurora, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Spring and Willamette River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of domestic use of one family, commercial use in cafe and marina, and irrigation of 0.2 acre

under Permit No. 28847 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 22, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second; being 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation from Willamette River and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.02 c.f.s. for commercial use from spring

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Boone DLC 47, Section 23, T. 3 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Commercial, Domestic, and 0.2 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
as projected within Boone DLC 47  
Section 23  
T. 3 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Diversion points located: Spring - 900 feet South and 330 feet West; River - 320 feet North and 950 feet West; both from the NE Corner, Boone DLC 47.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
