This Is to Certify, That
Route 2, Box 185, Sherwood
of 5511 S. W. Vermont, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
a spring fed stream and two reservoirs constructed under Application No. R-37770,
Permit No. R-2996
a tributary of South Fork of Scappoose Creek for the purpose of
domestic use of one family including the irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre lawn
and garden, recreation and wildlife
under Permit No. 28129 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from June 18, 1962 for 0.01 c.f.s.
June 29, 1962 for 0.04 c.f.s.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.05 cubic foot per second; being 0.01 c.f.s. from stream for domestic, and 0.02
c.f.s. from North Reservoir and stream and 0.02 c.f.s. from South Reservoir and
stream for recreation and wildlife
or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 16; SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 17, T. 3 N.,
R. 2 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

Recreation and Wildlife NW 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 16

Domestic, Recreation and Wildlife SE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 17
T. 3 N., R. 2 W., W. M.

Diversion points located 430 feet South and 80 feet West; 320 feet South; 320
feet North and 500 feet East; all from NW Corner, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 16.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
