CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WALTER M. and ONA M. THOMAS

of Idlelyd Route, Box 274, Roseburg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 2.5 acres and domestic use of three families

under Permit No. 30741 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 5, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second; being 0.03 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Foster DLC 43, Section 13, T. 26 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion point located 2340 feet North and 960 feet East from SW Corner, Section 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 2.5 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within Foster DLC 43
Section 13
T. 26 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
