**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** HOMER W. BARRY

of John Day, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Luce Creek and John Day River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 13.0 acres and supplemental irrigation of 9.0 acres

under Permit No. 27553 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 7, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.56 cubic foot per second; being 0.05 c.f.s. from Luce Creek for supplemental irrigation; 0.18 c.f.s. from John Day River for supplemental irrigation and 0.33 c.f.s. from Luce Creek for primary irrigation. Any deficiency in the flow available\* or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 22; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 29, T. 13 S., R. 31 E., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* in Luce Creek under the appropriation allowed herein for primary irrigation shall be made up by diversion from John Day River.

Diversion points located: Luce Creek - 5670 feet South and 2240 feet East from W $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 20; John Day River - 1000 feet North and 10 feet East from S $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 22;

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
