This Is to Certify, That FRANK H. and CHARLOTTE E. HAZELTON

of 1115 S. W. Elizabeth, Newport , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream

a tributary of Elk Creek irrigation of 0.7 acre

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 27964 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of scid waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 4, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 oubiv foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NEL NEL), Section 13, T. 22 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Diversion point located 560 feet South and 390 feet West from the NE Corner. Section 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the Umpqua River is more than 525 c.f.s. at tidewater;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.7 acre Lot 1 (NE¹ NE¹ NE

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
