## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

DOUGLAS COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 12

of Glide Public Schools, Glide , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

for the purpose of

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation, school use and domestic use of two families

under Permit No. 29622 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby March 31, 1964 confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.26 cubic foot per second; being 0.20 c.f.s. for irrigation, 0.05 c.f.s. for school use and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Nv $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 19, T. 26 S., R. 3 W., W. M. Diversion point located 400 feet South and 610 feet West from N $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right in appurtenant, is as follows:

> Domestic, school use, and 12.0 acres NV NE Domestic, school use, and 4.0 acres NEL NWL both as projected within Shrum DLC 42 Section 19 T. 26 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
