CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WAYNE A. MEEDS

of P. O. Box 177, Jacksonville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Right Fork Forest Creek and spring

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 20.2 acres and domestic use of one family

under Permit No. 28108 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 30, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.26 cubic foot per second; being 0.25 c.f.s. from Right Fork Forest Creek for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. from spring for domestic use

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, T. 37 S., R. 3 W., W. M. SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, T. 38 S., R. 3 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $4\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water for irrigation shall be limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River at its mouth is more than 735 c.f.s.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Domestic SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
13.2 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 3
T. 38 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

Diversion points located 5800 feet North and 50 feet East; 2920 feet North and 590 feet East; Spring - 620 feet North and 290 feet East; all from the SW Corner, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
