**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That            JOHN B. BATES**

of 225 Bush Street, San Francisco, State of California, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Hunter Creek and Pond No. 1, constructed under Application No. R-38442, Permit No. R-3224 a tributary of Grande Ronde River for the purpose of irrigation of 33.1 acres and supplemental irrigation of 17.9 acres

under Permit No. 28680 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 22, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.75 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 15, SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 16, T. 2 S., R. 38 E., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow for lands described as primary and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $\frac{3}{4}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under permit number R-3224, and further limited to the use of stored water only on lands described as supplemental; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Lower Grande Ronde River is more than 300 c.f.s. at USGS Gage No. 3325 and more than 420 c.f.s. at Oregon-Washington border; and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Diversion points located 1320 feet North and 30 feet West; 20 feet North and 1750 feet East; all from the W $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 15.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
