CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **JAMES A. and MARY JANE BANDUCCI**

of **Box 104, Umpqua** , State of **Oregon** , has made proof to the satisfaction of the **STATE ENGINEER** of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Umpqua River**

a tributary of **Pacific Ocean** for the purpose of **irrigation of 161.3 acres**

under Permit No. **28615** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **February 8, 1963**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **1.78 cubic feet per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected within **Emmett DLC 39, Section 31, T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W. M.** Diversion point located **2020 feet South and 950 feet East from the most Northerly NW Corner, Emmett DLC 39.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Umpqua River is more than **525 c.f.s.** at tidewater;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
