CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That O. GORDON HUDSON and/or LOYAL F. LUST

of 349 Windsor Avenue, Medford, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation of 0.5 acre and domestic use of two families

under Permit No. 29251 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 29, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second; being 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, T. 33 S., R. 1 E., W. M. Diversion point located 1650 feet North and 1240 feet West from E $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $4\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water for irrigation shall be limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth, more than 1000 c.f.s. immediately above Savage Rapids Dam and more than 1000 c.f.s. at Raygold;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.1 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Domestic and 0.4 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 31
T. 33 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
