of 444 Union Avenue, Grants Pass , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River washing sand and gravel

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 28606 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 30, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $NE_{\frac{1}{4}}^{1}$ Section 30, T. 36 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Diversion point located 530 feet South and 1040 feet West from the $E_{\frac{1}{4}}^{1}$ Corner, Section 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NET SET Section 30 T. 36 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

This permit is issued subject to the maintenance and use of adequate treatment facilities to remove the sediment before returning the water to the stream; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
