CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ROY J. and CLARA G. MORRISON

of 3650 Foothill Blvd., Grants Pass , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of two springs

a tributary of Bloody Rum Creek (Rogue River) irrigation of 4.1 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 31132 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 9, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.022 cubic foot per second, being 0.011 c.f.s. from each spring

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL SWL, SWL, SWL, Section 14, T. 36 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Springs located: North Spring - 1830 feet North and 470 feet East; South Spring - 1040 feet North and 330 feet West; both from the SL Corner, Section 14. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to reced 42 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

North Spring South Spring

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
