CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That STATE PARKS and RECREATION DIVISION of the OREGON STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT of Room 301, Highway Building, Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of Sulphur Creek for the purpose of public park use

under Permit No. 28223 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 30, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 20, T. 5 S., R. 9 W., W. M. Diversion point located 1700 feet South and 4000 feet West from the NE Corner, Section 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4
Lot 5 (SE 1/4 NE 1/4)
Section 20
T. 6 S., R. 9 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
