## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Route 2, Box 268, Silverton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of unnamed stream (Pudding River) irrigation of 133.2 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-5130 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 4, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.20 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4 SW4, as projected within Greenwood DLC 57, Section 1, T. 7 S., R. 2 W., W. M. Diversion point located 1290 feet South and 940 feet East from the SE Corner, Murphey DLC 58.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for such acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each years

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

22.7 acres SE<sub>4</sub> SE<sub>4</sub>
both as projected within Greenwood DLC 57

T. 7 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
