of Rt. 4, Box 142, Hillsboro , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of three wells

a tributary of Tualatin River irrigation of 11.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-3459 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 10, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.138 cubic foot per second, being 0.046 c.f.s. from each well

The point of diversion is located in the NN $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SN $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Fig. DLC 68, Section 8, T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W. M. Wells located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Wells located: No. 1 - 1920 feet North and 2010 feet West; No. 2 - 1070 feet North and 2170 feet West; No. 3 - 1440 feet North and 2330 feet West; all from the S_{L}^{1} Corner, Section 8.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
