**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**      **RAYMOND O. STALEY and ETHEL L. STALEY**

of P. O. Box 666 (Rt. 38, Box 11 A), Drain, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of four springs

a tributary of Elk Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 6.6 acres, domestic use of one family, and stock

under Permit No. 28285 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 30, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.069 cubic foot per second; being 0.003 c.f.s. from Spring No. 1, 0.003 c.f.s. from Spring No. 2, 0.004 c.f.s. from Spring No. 3 for Stock, and 0.007 c.f.s. from Spring No. 1, 0.037 c.f.s. from Spring No. 2, 0.01 c.f.s. from Spring \* or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 11, T. 22 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Springs located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Umpqua River is more than 525 c.f.s. at tidewater,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* No. 4 for irrigation, and 0.005 c.f.s. from Spring No. 4 for domestic, Springs located: No. 1 - 20 feet North and 230 feet West; No. 2 - 310 feet North and 320 feet West; No. 3 - 60 feet North and 420 feet West; No. 4 - 380 feet North and 400 feet West, all from the SE Corner, Section 11. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
