CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ELMER and LA VERNE BRISLER

of Box 381, Lorane, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of two unnamed streams

a tributary of Siuslaw River for the purpose of domestic use of two families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden under Permit No. 31217 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 4, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second; being 0.005 c.f.s. from North stream for one house and 0.005 c.f.s. from South stream for one house

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 22, T. 20 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Diversion points located 1190 feet North and 1160 feet East; 720 feet North and 930 feet East; both from the Center, Section 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 22
T. 20 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
