CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CROWN ZELLERBACH CORPORATION
WESTERN-WAXIDE DIVISION

of P. O. Box 218, North Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
two wells

a tributary of Oregon Slough (Columbia River) for the purpose of
industrial use

under Permit No. G-2731 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from July 20, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
5.88 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within Brown DLC 38,
Section 33, T. 2 N., R. 1 E., W. M. Wells located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Brown DLC 38
Section 32

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Brown DLC 38
Section 33
T. 2 N., R. 1 E., W. M.

Wells located: No. 1 - 2100.4 feet North and 4843.8 feet West; No. 2 - 2097.1
feet North and 5047.6 feet West; both from the SE Corner, Section 33.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
