CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of 22865 W. Baseline, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Beaverton Creek, tributary of Rock Creek (Tualatin River), appropriated under Appl. No. 40799, Permit No. 30398,

for the purposes of fish culture under Reservoir Permit No. R-4568 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 26, 1965

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 2.8 acre feet
