CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ESTATE OF JOHN C. McNEIL

of Route 2, Box 265, Sheridan , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring and unnamed stream

a tributary of Dear Creek for the purpose of domestic use of one family and irrigation of 0.5 acre

under Permit No. 31507 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 21, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. from spring for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. from spring and stream for irrigation,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Warren DLC 50, Section 11, T. 5 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 0.5 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within Warren DLC 50
Section 11
T. 5 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

Diversion points located: Spring - 830 feet South and 380 feet East; Stream - 770 feet South and 500 feet West, both from the NE Corner, Section 11.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
