## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JOHN MILTON CONRAD

of Route 1, Box 72, Bandon , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of ummamed tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 3.2 acres, cranberry harvesting and frost control on 3.2 acres

under Permit No. **G-3158** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **July 27, 1966** 

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second, being 0.04 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.65 c.f.s. for harvesting and frost control

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWL NEL, Section 28, T. 28 S., R. 14 W., W. M. Well located 1390 feet South and 490 feet East from NL Corner, Section 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Supplemental irrigation, cranberry harvesting and frost control on 3.2 acres

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
