CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. E. NANCE

of 29555 Rainsford Place, Malibu, State of California, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-37523, Permit No. R-2961, a tributary of Hubbard Creek for the purpose of domestic use of one family, fish culture

under Permit No. 28029 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 4, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from spring for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. from stream and reservoir for fish culture,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 21, T. 25 S., R. 7 W., W. M. Diversion points located: Spring - 1840 feet South and 2640 feet East; Stream - 1530 feet South and 2320 feet East both from NW Corner, Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and Fish Culture SE 1/4 NW 1/4  
Section 21  
T. 25 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

This right is subject to the terms and conditions of the decree of the Circuit Court for Douglas County Dated April 17, 1963, and recorded at page 145, Miscellaneous Decree Record of the State Engineer; provided further that the right to use of water for fish culture and recreation within the reservoir is limited to the period when the flow of the Umpqua River at tidewater is more than 525 c.f.s.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
