This Is to Certify, That DON E. & BETTY J. BAILEY

 to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of
 Livingston Creek with any deficiency to be made up from Dear Creek, tributary
 of South Umpqua River in Dixonville log pond constructed under Permit No. R-1918,
 appropriated under Application No. 39239, Permit No. 29158
 for the purposes of
 irrigation
 under Reservoir Permit No. R-3861 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said
 waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right
 hereby confirmed dates from November 12, 1963

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes afore-
 said, shall not exceed 260.0 acre feet
