**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This is to Certify, That** **ADAM KOLB**

of **Baker**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the **STATE WATER BOARD** of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Reservoir, City of Baker water supply (Overflow)**, a tributary of **Powder River** for the purpose of **irrigation** under Permit No. **4378** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the **STATE WATER BOARD** of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume **1**, at page **434**, on the **19th** day of **April**, **1922**; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **December 29, 1919**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.50** cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: **2 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 33 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter and 5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Nineteen, Township Nine South, Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon. Being a total of 40 acres.**

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
