**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**      **PAUL M. ROBINSON**

of Route 1, Box 464, Eagle Point, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Langel Creek and Robinson Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-39161, Permit No. R-3697 a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 1.6 acres

under Permit No. 29021 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **October 11, 1963**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.02 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 34, T. 34 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **4 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet** per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under permit No. R-3697; provided further that the right to use of direct flow is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 1000 c.f.s. immediately above Savage Rapids Dam, more than 1000 c.f.s. at Raygold and more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.6 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 34  
T. 34 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Diversion points located: Creek - 40 feet South and 1700 feet East; 340 feet South and 1230 feet East; Reservoir - 300 feet South and 1400 feet East; all from W $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 34.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
