CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LEO EISELSTEIN

of Rt. 1, Box 62, Dayton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Lambert Slough

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 4.0 acres

under Permit No. 30636 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 30, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Lason DLC 54, Section 9, T. 5 S., R. 3 W., W. M. Diversion point located 320 feet North and 225 feet East from the SE Corner, Cooper DLC 53.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.4 acres	SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Cooper DLC 53 Section 9
0.6 acre	NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Hewitt DLC 56
1.0 acre	NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Hewitt DLC 56 Section 16 T. 5 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
