that the amount of water to which such right is cutitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is

The Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Thirty-six Township Thirty-four South, Range Eight West of Willamette Meridian, in Josephine County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
