An order of the State Engineer entered September 16, 1946, approved a change in the use of water for the remainder of the right described in the Decree, and this was confirmed by the certificate of water right recorded at page 16024, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
