**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is To Certify, That** JAMES F. and LURLINE R. COONAN

of Harcross Road, Woodside, State of California, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Salt Creek, Yew Creek and Wade Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-30030\* a tributary of Little Butte Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 290.0 acres under Permit No. 27418 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 31, 1955

; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.63 cubic feet per second; being 1.94 c.f.s. from Salt Creek and 1.69 c.f.s. from Yew Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 10; NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 11, T. 36 S., R. 2 E., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1716;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Diversion points located: Salt Creek - 850 feet East and 710 feet South; Yew Creek - 790 feet East and 1100 feet South; both from the NE Corner, Section 11; Reservoir - 1020 feet North and 2540 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 10.

Certificate of water right issued to James F. & Lurline R. Coonan and recorded at page 35227, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 295.0 acres. A change in the right to the use of water appurtenant to 5.0 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered December 18, 1968. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to James F. and Lurline R. Coonan.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
