CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ANNIE E. KINSEY, on behalf and as guardian of ELMER L. and MINNIE L. KINSEY, minors; and as AGENT for VIOLA KINSEY MARTIN, HATTIE KINSEY JOHNSON, LEON KINSEY, MABEL KINSEY FARBER, EDW. F. KINSEY, and RHODA KINSEY COUNDAUX, of Payette, State of Idaho, has a right to the use of the waters of Pine Creek

a tributary of Snake River for the purpose of irrigation of 39.0 acres, and domestic and stock use and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 11, at page 235 & 399; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1874 for Tract No. 1, and 1886 for Tract No. 3;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre, measured at the point of diversion, and a total limitation of one acre-foot per acre during July, one acre-foot per acre during August, and one-half acre-foot per acre during September, of each year.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, T. 7 S., R. 45 E., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Tract No. 1

2.0 acres described as being within Lots 5, 6 and 7, Block 3 of Claud Officer's First Addition to Town of Halfway and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8. Commencing at a point E. of NW Corner of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17; thence S. 110 ft.; thence E. 50 ft.; thence N. 110 ft.; thence W. 50 ft. in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, all being in T. 8 S., R. 46 E., W. M. ALSO: Commencing at a point 627 ft. E. of NW Corner of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17; thence S. 90 ft.; thence W. 140 ft.; thence N. 220 ft.; thence E. 140 ft.; thence N. 200 ft.; thence E. 100 ft.; thence N. 20 ft.; thence W. 50 ft.; thence N. 90 ft.; thence W. 50 ft.; to place of beginning and being in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, T. 8 S., R. 46 E., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Annie E. Kinsey, on behalf and as guardian of Elmer L. and Minnie L. Kinsey, minors; and as Agent for Viola Kinsey Martin, Hattie Kinsey Johnson, Leon Kinsey, Mable Kinsey Farber, Edw. F. Kinsey, and Rhoda Kinsey Coundaux and recorded at page 10358, Volume 10, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for domestic and stock and irrigation of 118.0 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion for the irrigation of 79.0 acres was changed by order of the State Engineer entered October 24, 1968. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for domestic, stock, and irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
