CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CITY OF ASHLAND

of Ashland, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Ashland Creek

a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of municipal use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1858;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, T. 39 S., R. 1 E., W. M. Diversion point located 100 feet North and 10 feet West from SE Corner, Section 20. A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in the use, place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered August 16, 1966, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Henry Haynes and recorded at page 16015, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
