that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per acre during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in Paragraph 24 of said decree.)

Certificate of water right issued to F. E. McCorkle and recorded at page 5756, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 25.0 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion for the irrigation of 8.0 acres was changed by order of the State Engineer entered December 12, 1968. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to F. E. McCorkle.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
