CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That A. J., RUBY M. and GLEN W. DEPUY

of Route 1, Box 217, Rogue River, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Ditch Creek

a tributary of Pleasant Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 25.0 acres
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1891;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.364 cubic foot per
second.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

25.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 4
T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Jas. Owens and recorded at page 16137,
Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the
use of water for irrigation of 27.5 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use
of water appurtenant to 2.5 acres was canceled by order of the State Engineer
entered May 1, 1969. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining
right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate here-
tofore issued to Jas. Owens.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
